

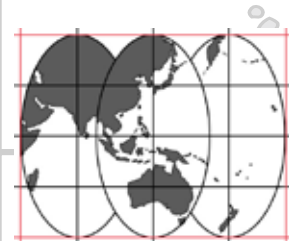

As the world's largest labour force, China's workforce is the engine driving China into the centre of the world economic stage. Explore the new labour laws which regulate China's workforce.

Topic Three: Practical difficulties in litigating employment issues

Delve into the challenges of litigating employment issues. Litigation is a powerful forum to air grievances and enable disputes to be resolved but are there unnecessary procedural barriers, has information technology made liability issues unduly complex and can litigation be made simpler and less costly?

- Speakers from Malaysia, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Japan, China and Australia will explore these issues.
